Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission after 1st Appeal to S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder with respect to appeal dated 04.08.2025 - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the Principal, S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) vide ref. letter no. Sanamcrckpl/reminder/2025-26/16 dated 04.08.2025 to the Commission against the 2nd Renewal of Permission with seat reduction in UG (BAMS) course issued to S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) with intake capacity of 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) due to non fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcomings as mentioned in 2nd Renewal of Permission with seat reduction in UG vide letter of even no. dated 22.07.2025.
2. The submission made by the Principal, S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and it has been decided by the Chairman, NCISM to consider the appeal wherein it is mentioned that the shortcomings/deficiencies shall be fulfilled at the earliest and requesting for Grant of Yearly permission to S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course as per the concerned acts & regulations for the academic session 2025-26.
3. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. 51-27/2025-26/Comm.Appeal/College(Ayu.) dated 12.09.2025 to grant Yearly Permission to S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per the concerned acts & regulations.

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, in view of above, S A Ningoji Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Dadegal, Koppal -583231 (Inst. Id-AYU0825) is hereby granted with :-

2nd Renewal of Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 64 (3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024.

5. The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-

- (i) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 60 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. You are hereby instructed to comply with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
10. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-27 :-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.
 - iv) All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
